

In order to support the health and safety of our students, teachers, staff, and community, the following policies are effective June 20, 2022:

COVID-19 POLICY – ALL STUDENTS

1. While on campus, all students, regardless of age, are required to be up to date with all COVID-19 vaccines meaning that the student has received all recommended COVID-19 vaccines including any booster dose(s) when eligible (the “Vaccine Requirement”).
2. Masks are no longer required but are **strongly encouraged**.
3. Individuals who are unable to comply with the Vaccine Requirement may request a reasonable accommodation. To discuss potential accommodations, please contact Roxanne Heaton, Executive Director.
4. Students must provide acknowledgment that they will abide by the COVID-19 Policy.
5. All students shall provide the Minnetonka Center for the Arts the following information confirming their vaccination status (“CONFIDENTIAL SELF-CERTIFICATION VACCINATION ATTESTATION”):
 - a. Attestation that they are be up to date with all COVID-19 vaccines meaning that the student has received all recommended COVID-19 vaccines including any booster dose(s) when eligible.
 - b. Manufacturer of vaccine and booster(s) received (e.g., Pfizer, Moderna, or Johnson & Johnson).

COVID-19 POLICY – BUILDING & GENERAL PUBLIC

1. Minnetonka Center for the Arts will comply with any applicable COVID-19 CDC Guidelines regarding social distancing, vaccine and mask requirements.
2. Signs shall be posted strongly recommending all visitors wear a well-fitting mask covering the nose and mouth at all times while indoors.
