

CALL FOR ENTRIES: *The Student Show 2023*

February 17 – March 31, 2023

INTAKE: February 4, 9 a.m. – 1 p.m.

Eligibility

Any student (age 16+) who has been enrolled in a MCFTA class between September 7, 2021 and December 31, 2022, may exhibit. One piece may be entered per series class or workshop taken, up to a maximum of two pieces per student. (*The same class taken multiple times with the same instructor counts as one class.*) Entries must reflect the medium and the purpose of the class taken.

What to Enter

All media, 2-D and 3-D, except installation and video, will be considered.

Maximum height, width, or depth per entry is 72 inches.

Works must be original and completed between September 7, 2021 and December 31, 2022.

Work must be executed solely by the student. Work exhibited in previous Art Center shows will not be accepted.

Process

Complete an inventory tag for each entry (below). Fill out both halves for each entry.

To ensure accurate exhibit labels for your work, write legibly and make sure the tags are easily readable.

Attach completed tag to the hanging wire of a 2-D piece, or the bottom of a 3-D piece.

Sales & Promotion

Exhibitors are encouraged, but not required, to offer their work for sale.

If NFS, a retail value must be specified for insurance purposes. No specified value = no insurance.

The Art Center will retain a commission on all sales of work: 40% for Members, 50% for Non-Members.

Gallery installations may be photographed for promotional purposes. Individual artists may not be credited in photographs of gallery installations.

Requirements

All submitted artwork must be ready to display.

2-D work must be dry, framed (or wrapped, finished edges on canvases) and securely wired for hanging.

3-D work must be stable and structurally sound.

Acetate or shrink-wrapped work will not be accepted.

Liability

Works for which value has been stated are insured by the Minnetonka Center for the Arts from the intake through the designated pick-up.

Delivery and pickup of artwork is the responsibility of the artist.

The Minnetonka Center for the Arts is not responsible for loss or damage of artwork not picked up on time.

Intake

Deliver work to the Laura H. Miles Gallery on Saturday, February 4, 9 a.m. – 1 p.m. (FIRM)

Pick-up

Pick up unsold artwork on Saturday, April 1, 9 a.m. – 1 p.m. (FIRM)
