Minnetonka Center for the Arts' Partners in Art at Ridgedale Center (12401 Wayzata Blvd, Minnetonka)

Up Close and Sculptural is a curated selection of small-scale sculpture and fine craft objects celebrating the vitality and variety of Minnesota sculptors' work, displayed in covered vitrines throughout the common areas of Ridgedale Center. **Up Close and Sculptural** is presented as part of Minnetonka Center for the Arts' ongoing art partnership with Ridgedale Center, **Partners in Art**.

- Artists are invited to submit up to twelve (12) pieces of original sculpture.
- Eligibility: Open to artists residing in Minnesota, Iowa and Wisconsin.
- Submissions must be received by September 20, 2024. Notifications of acceptance will be made by email by September 30, 2024.
- Intake of accepted work October 1-15, 2024.

What to Enter:

- All types of sculpture and techniques will be considered
- Works must be original, executed by the artist, and completed within the past 5 years
- All work must be for sale. The art center will retain a 40% commission on sales of work by MCFTA
 members and a 50% commission on sales of work by non-members. Artists need not be
 members of MCFTA to apply or exhibit.
- Applicants are encouraged to submit a number of pieces. Different types of work may be submitted, and an artist's work will not necessarily all be displayed together
- Submitted pieces must be no taller than 28 inches

Process:

Submissions must include image list specifying the medium, size, and retail price of each piece. Include an artist's statement and/or CV/resume.

Presentation:

Works must be ready to display, stable and structurally sound.

Liability:

- Work will be insured by the Art Center from the time of delivery through pick-up.
- **Delivery and pick-up of accepted work** is the responsibility of the artist. Entries submitted by mail or delivery service must include prepaid return shipping label.
